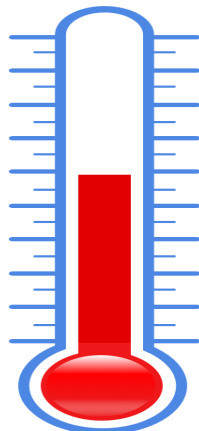

The funds will go to help with the Convent Renovation. So far we have collected \$65,867. Thankfully we have been blessed with some volunteer workers, otherwise it would have cost a great deal more.

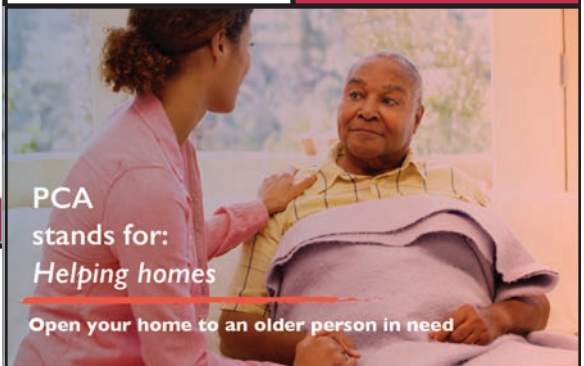
