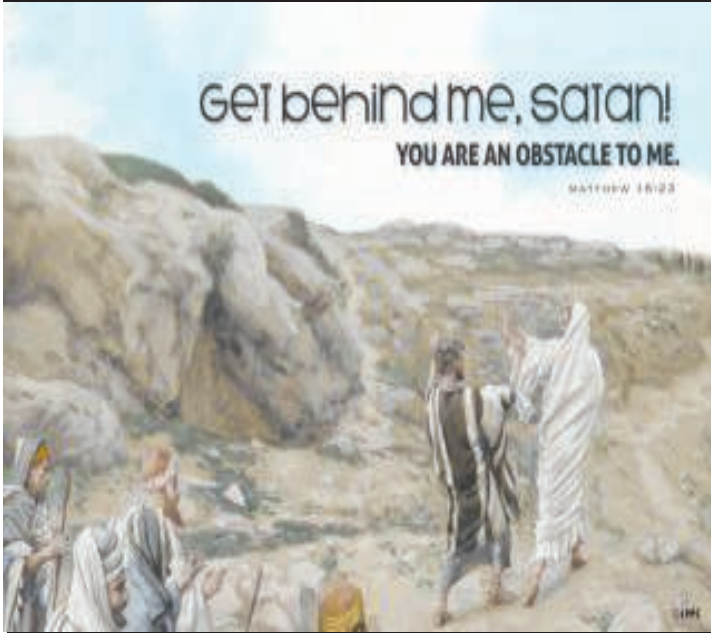

PASTOR'S NOTE

The observance of Labor Day, on Sept. 4th, launches us into the month of September, and for many, marks the conclusion of the summer season. BAPTISM

Baptisms are celebrated on Sunday's at 10:15 am & Spanish at 11:30am. Prior to the celebration of Baptism, attendance at the Pre-Jordan Program is mandatory for both parents. Godparents must be baptized Catholics, at least 16 years of age, who have received the sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation. If married, they must be married in the Catholic Church, regularly attending Mass on Sunday, and living their faith. If the godparents are not from Our Lady of Consolation Parish, they must present a certificate of eligibility from their own parish. Requirements will be explained at the Pre-Jordan Class.

MARRIAGE

The Sacrament of Matrimony is a holy covenant between a man and a woman, entered into freely and solemnly before God. Engaged couples should set the marriage date with the Church at least six months in advance. This will allow enough time to attend the Pre-Cana Instructions, gather all the proper documents, obtain any dispensations, and plan and prepare for the liturgical celebration. Please do not make any reception arrangements until your wedding date is confirmed by a priest.

BAUTISMO

Los bautismos se celebran los domingos a las 10:15 am y el español a las 11:30 am. Antes de la celebración del Bautismo, la asistencia al Programa Pre-Jordania es obligatoria para ambos padres. Los padrinos deben ser católicos bautizados, de al menos 16 años de edad, que hayan recibido los sacramentos de la Eucaristía y la Confirmación. Si están casados, deben estar casados en la Iglesia Católica, asistir regularmente a misa los domingos y vivir su fe. Si los padrinos no son de la parroquia de Nuestra Señora de la Consolación, deben presentar un certificado de elegibilidad de su propia parroquia. Los requisitos se explicarán en la clase Pre-Jordania.

MATRIMONIO

El sacramento del matrimonio es una santa alianza entre un hombre y una mujer, celebrada libre y solemnemente ante Dios. Las parejas comprometidas deben fijar la fecha de matrimonio con la Iglesia con al menos seis meses de anticipación. Esto permitirá suficiente tiempo para asistir a las Instrucciones Pre-Cana, reunir todos los documentos apropiados, obtener cualquier dispensa y planificar y prepararse para la celebración litúrgica. Por favor, no haga ningún arreglo de recepción hasta que la fecha de su boda sea confirmada por un sacerdote.
