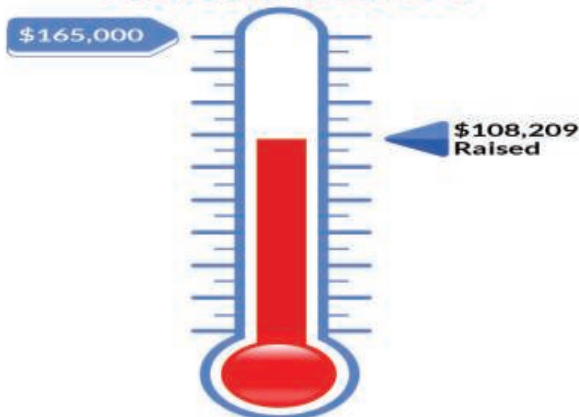

BAPTISM

Prior to your child's Baptism, attendance at the Pre-Jordan Program is mandatory for both parents. At least one parent must be Baptized catholic, and must be registered at OLC for more than 6 months. The Godparents, one or both, must be Catholics, at least 16 years of age, and who have received the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation. If the Godparents are not Registered Parishioners at Our Lady of Consolation, they must present a "letter of eligibility" from the parish in which they are registered before the parents can set a date for Baptism.

NEW PARISHIONERS

New parishioners are most welcome and are encouraged to register as soon as possible after moving into the parish. You can find registration forms in the vestibule.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Arrangements for the Sacrament of Marriage must be made with one of the parish priests at least six months before the wedding date. Call the Rectory to schedule an appointment.

VISITS TO SICK AND HOMEBOUND

BAUTISMO

Antes del Bautismo de su hijo, la asistencia al Programa Pre-Jordan es obligatoria para ambos padres, al menos uno de los padres debe ser católico bautizado, también debe estar registrado en OLC por más de 6 meses. Los Padrinos (uno o ambos) deben ser católicos, mayores de 16 años, que hayan recibido los sacramentos del Bautismo y la Confirmación. Si los padrinos no son feligreses registrados en Our Lady of Consolation, deben presentar una "carta de elegibilidad" de la parroquia en la que están registrados antes de que los padres puedan fijar una fecha para el bautismo.
