### BAPTISM

Prior to your child's Baptism, attendance at the Pre-Jordan Program is mandatory for both parents. At least one parent must be baptized Catholic and must be registered at OLC for more than 6 months. The Godparents (one or both) must be Catholics, at least 16 years of age, and received the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation. If the Godparents are not Registered Parishioners at Our Lady of Consolation they must present a "letter of eligibility" from the parish in which they are registered in before the parents can set a date for Baptism.

### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE
