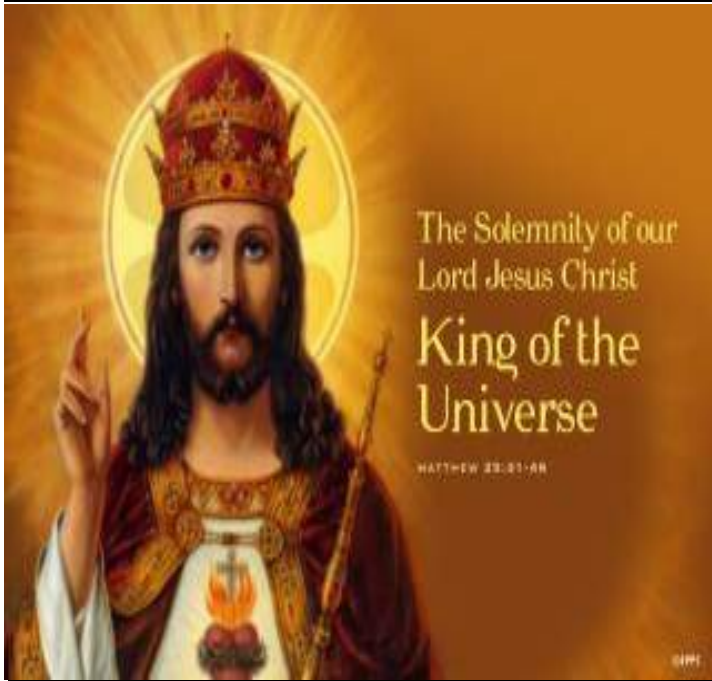

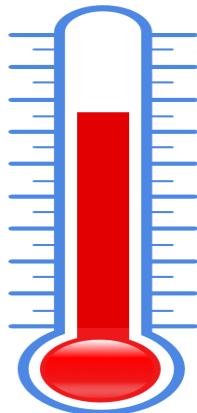

### **Jubilee Year 2025**

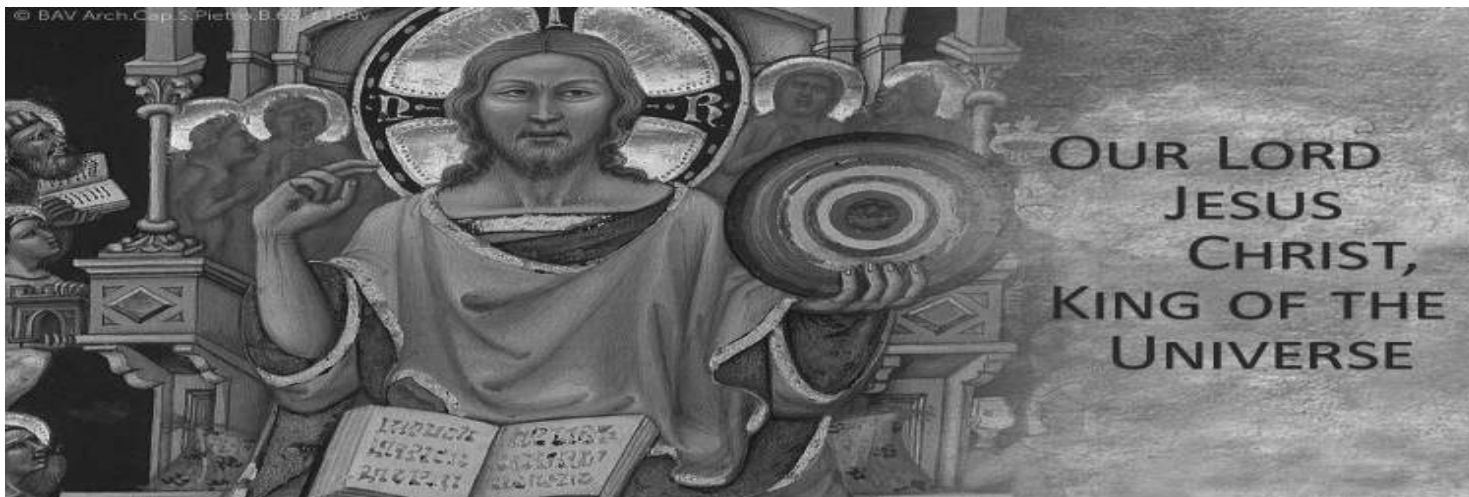

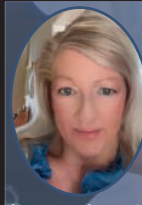
