Nov. 15: Parish Thanksgiving in the church hall from 3:00PM - 5:00PM. A sign-up sheet will be posted.

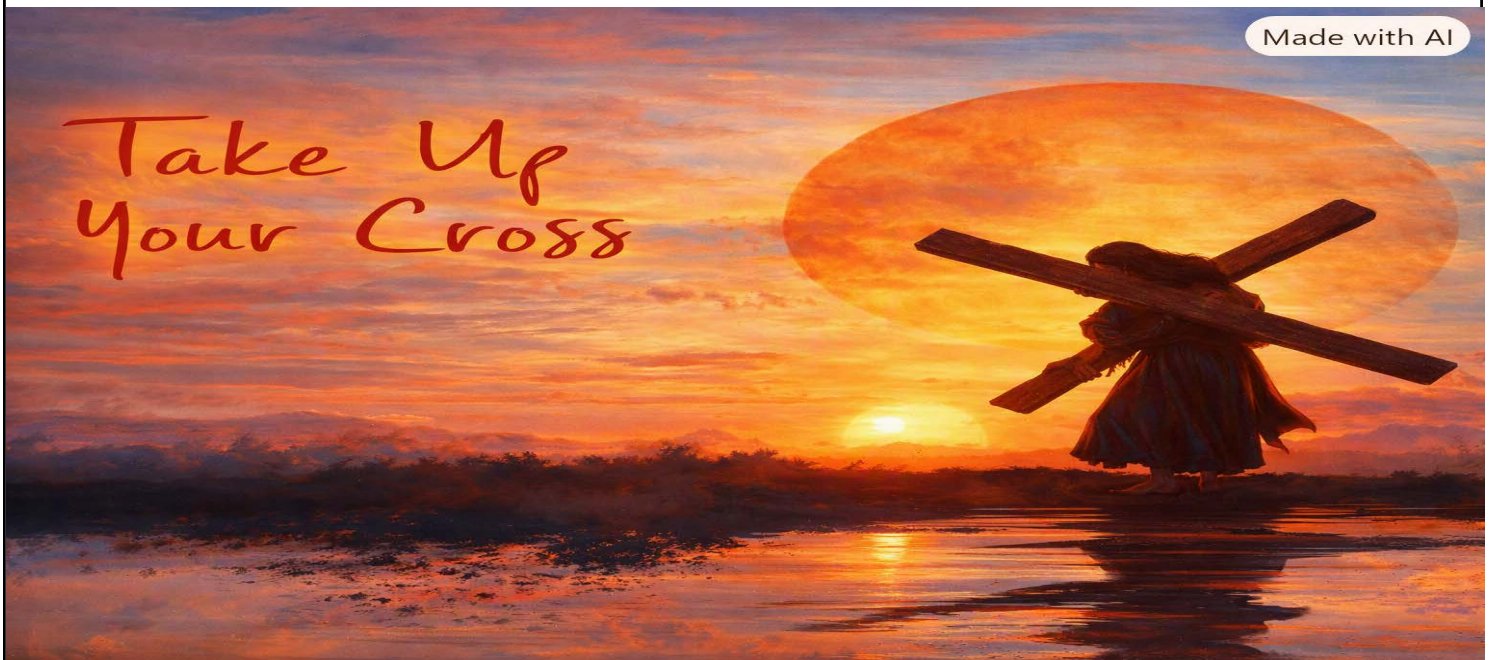

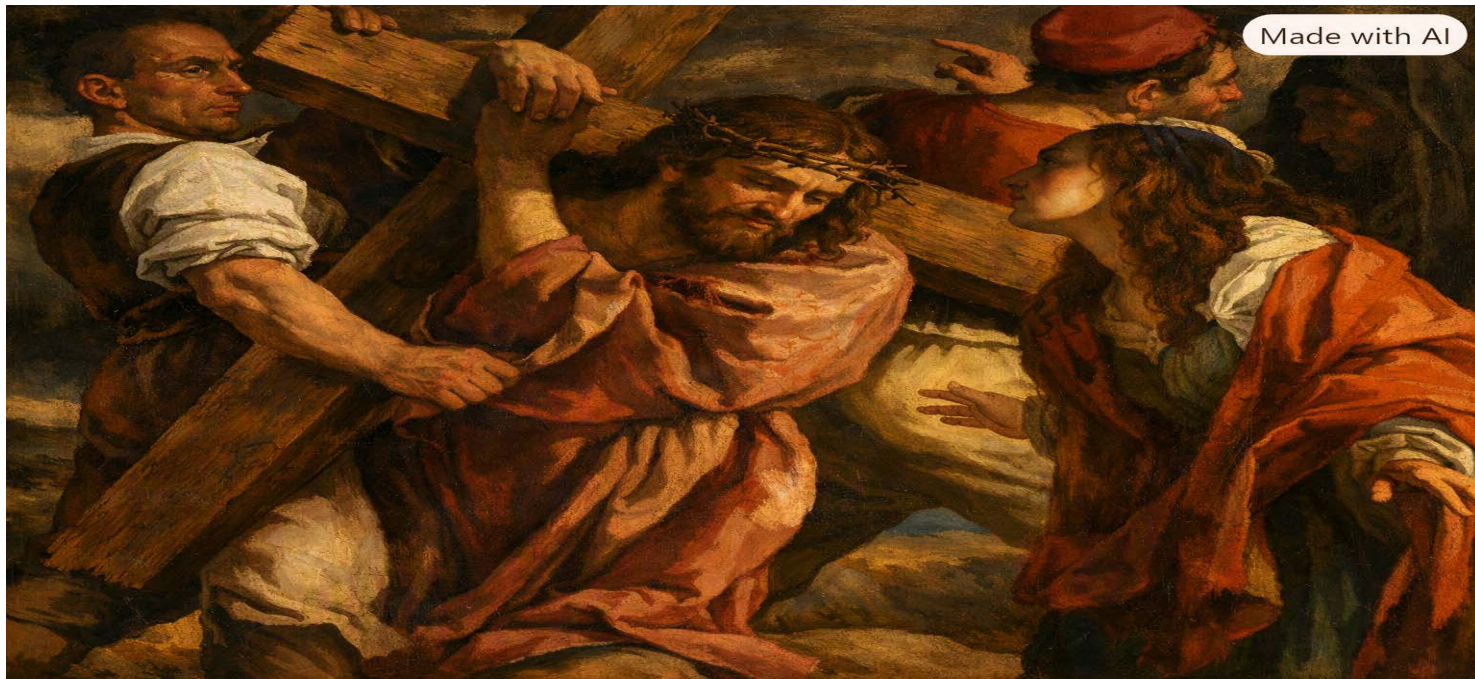
