RETROUVAILLE: REDESCUBRE EL AMOR EN TU MATRIMONIO

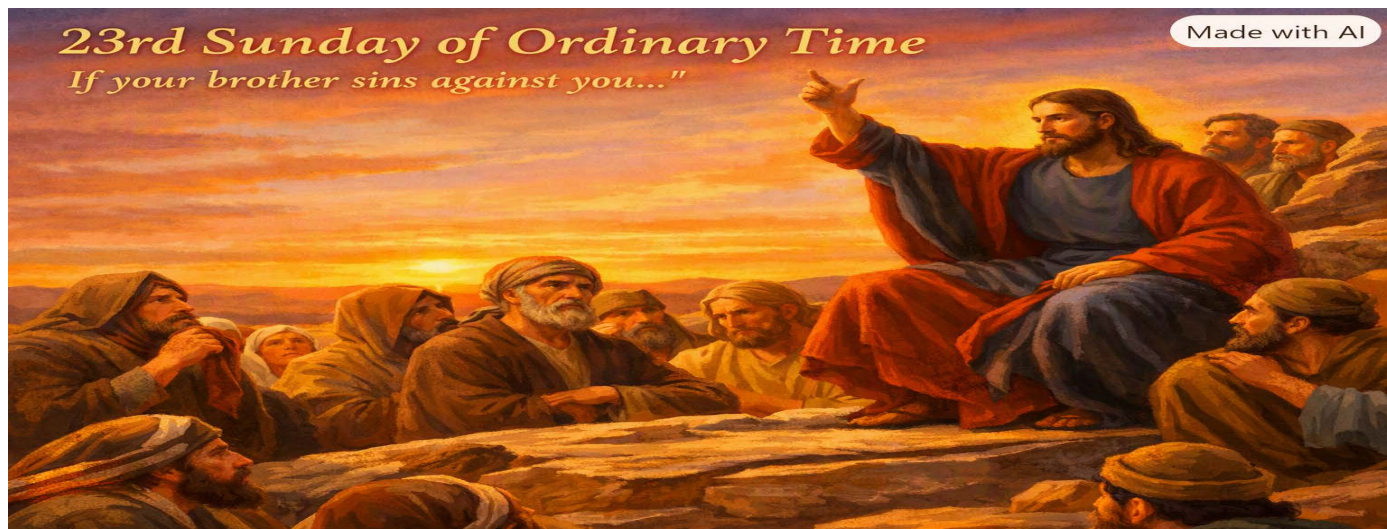
