Monday is a important feast called The Exaltation of The Cross. According to a traditional account, The Holy Cross was founded by St. Helena, the mother of Emperor Constantine the Great, on a pilgrimage to Jerusalem in 326 AD. Relics of The Holy Cross are around the world but most of them reside at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. This church was built by Constantine at the site of Jesus' burial. The feast reminds us of God's plan of salvation and His work to raise us up through the saving power of Jesus Christ.

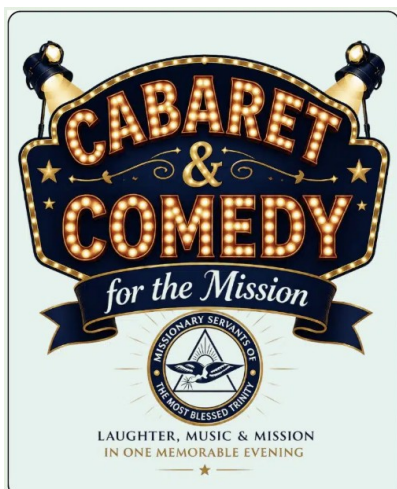
